IT Policy - AB has documented policy which has been reviewed by all Councillors. Updated version approved at meeting. Action closed DK Verge mowing – DK waiting to discuss with Richard Haycock who is back in the office on 26/9/25 WALC survey – this was completed and submitted on 29/8/25. Action closed **OPEN FORUM to Members of the Public** It was reported that just past the farm on Grandborough Fields Road the road is subsiding and dangerous to cars. April Knapp will report but would like others to report too. Neighbourhood Watch (NHW). DA explained that years ago Flecknoe was registered with the NHW scheme. This seems to have lapsed and DA had contacted Edward Palusinski (Rugby area NHW co-ordinator) to understand where our registration had gone. He arranged for Flecknoe to be added back onto the database. There are 12 individuals registered and these people will have received emails inviting them to join the Flecknoe NHW group. Gary Rigby and Mark Jervis were the original NHW Co-ordinators, however Mark Jervis has now resigned. The suggestion is that Gary and April Knapp meet and liaise with Edward with a view to relaunching NHW and involve and liaise with all areas of the community (elderly, boaters, all villages). It may extend to include safety and well-being at home. There was some discussion on what responsibility WPC has in relation to NHW and especially DK in relation to the implementation of Martyn's Law. DK agreed to investigate the responsibilities of the WPC in relation to NHW. KP to raise ticket with WALC with the same ΚP question. DK to mention to other Parish Councils to check if they are still registered with NHW scheme as DA had noticed that a number of local villages are not. Flecknoe Watch WhatsApp group was set up as a private group and run by an individual who has now closed it down. A parishioner raised the question of whether it was possible to have an advisory 20mph sign in Flecknoe, as Barby does. This has been investigated previously when it was determined that from a 60mph you cannot go straight to 20mph ie there needs to be an intermediary limit. DK DK agreed to follow up to see if this rule still stands. ΚP A parishioner raised the condition of the towpath between bridges 101 and 102 which is grossly overgrown and collapsing. KP to raise on CRT site. KP to draft letter for DA to send to KΡ CRT.

	A parishioner raised concern about the bullrushes in the pond with concern that the pond will get boggy if not removed. DA confirmed the recreation field team have been in touch with Warwickshire Wildlife Trust and have a plan for managing this.	
	A parishioner has read that we will have to start booking to use any of the Warwickshire tips with a suggestion that we might want to think about arranging for a monthly skip to come to the village.
